## *Who is it for?*

KGVI is designed to provide a continuous flow of trained leaders for The Boys' Brigade. The course is open to young men and women aged between 17 and 22, serving in any of the four sections: Anchors, Juniors, Company, Seniors.



## *How long does it last?*

The training is completed in three stages:

- ⇒ The New Entrants week – a full week of residential training
- ⇒ Supervised leadership within your own company
- ⇒ A second week of residential training, at least one year after the start of the New Entrants week

On satisfactory completion of training, cadets have completed the requirements to be appointed as a leader in The Boys' Brigade.

## *What will I do at KGVI?*

- ⇒ Full Youth Leader Training
- ⇒ Leadership & Teambuilding games
- ⇒ Relationship building scenarios
- ⇒ Physical activity sessions
- ⇒ Exploring and sharing the Christian faith
- ⇒ Team games and individual sporting competitions
- ⇒ Free time with full use of the recreational facilities at the centre for badminton, basketball, croquet, football, hockey, putting, table tennis and volleyball



## SCQF

KGVI has been SCQF credit rated by SQA at Level 7, with 13 credit points, for successful completion of the full programme. Level 7 is equivalent to the level for an advanced higher or HNC.

### *What will it cost?*

The cost of each week's training is £160 per cadet. The cost includes accommodation and meals for the week, together with the cost of the Wednesday afternoon outing and a course photograph.

An additional subsidy can be considered where there is more than one applicant from a Company. Speak to Scottish Headquarters for more information.
